ADDITIONAL DRESS CODE INFORMATION

- Hoodies, denim, sweats, or yoga pants may not be worn.
- A white, light blue, royal, or navy blue sweater, pullover, blazer or vest may be worn.
- Skirts must rest no more than two inches above the knee.
- Pants should fit properly for girls and boys.
- Sunglasses, bandanas, hats or any other types of headgear are not to be worn during school.
- Manufactured trademarks, if any, must be 1 inch or less.
- DAAS logos are permitted and can be any shape and size on all clothing pieces.
- Open toe shoes are not allowed.
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- Students are not allowed to wear coats or hoodies in class.
- Visible socks or tights must be white, navy or light blue or black.
- Shorts or capris are not allowed.
- Boots above the ankle may not be worn in class.
- Visible shirts underneath uniform must be a solid and neutral color.
- Watches and bracelets must be modest in quantity, size and color.
